Speakers at previous meetings include the Shadow Health Minister, Chief Executives and Senior Directors from commercial and non-commercial organisations including the National Institute for Health Research (NIHR), HRA, NHS, Syneos Health, Parexel and Re:Cognition Health to name a few. It provides an open forum to share best practices and innovation around clinical research workforce, systems/technology and processes.

- The title of your abstract or round table discussion topic.
- A summary of the content
- Your job title, contact details and organisation.
- What you are submitting - an application for an oral abstract or round table discussion topic (or if your subject would be applicable to both).

Submissions should be written in English. Titles should not exceed 100 characters and the topic description should not exceed 500 characters.
